

RESOLUTION NO. 84-13

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELAND, FLORIDA CREATING A COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND DESIGNATING THE DELAND CITY COMMISSION AS THE MEMBERS OF THE DELAND COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of DeLand on the 6th day of February, 1984 adopted Resolution No. 84-3 finding that there is one or more slum or blighted areas within the City of DeLand and that the rehabilitation, conservation or redevelopment thereof is in the best interests of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare of the residents of the City of DeLand; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of DeLand has designated an area as appropriate for a community redevelopment project; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of DeLand, on the 19th day of March, 1984, adopted Resolution No. 84-10 finding a need for a community redevelopment agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DELAND, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Commission hereby creates a Community Redevelopment Agency, a public agency created by Florida Statutes 163 Part III as amended by Chapter 83-29 and 83-231, Laws of Florida.

Section 2. The City Commission hereby appoints the DeLand City Commission as the members of the Community redevelopment Agency. Qualification of membership shall be governed by Florida Statute 163.357 (1983).

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
