Subject: Street Resurfacing Project 2015 -2016

The City of DeLand Public Works Department plans, prepares, and selects streets from the City’s 131.5 lane miles of City Roadways. Staff reviews the Pavement Condition (PCI), as well as pavement preservation options, which are proactive approach that consists of two components: preventive maintenance, and routine maintenance activities.

- Preventive maintenance is a planned strategy of treatments applied to pavement in good condition that still has significant life (crack sealing, slurry sealing).
- Routine Maintenance includes activities such as pothole patching, minor partial or full-depth pavement repairs, and isolated milling and asphalt overlays
